

Policies, Procedures and Rules of the Game

Disqualification Policy:

We have a zero tolerance policy for cheating or plagiarization of copyrighted material. If any member of the local chapter is found to be breaking this rule, the local NMSA Chapter will be immediately disqualified from the competition without warning.

Procedures:

To collect points, documentation and submission is necessary. Photo documentation is required for all events and are to be submitted along with the [Submission Form](#). Submission of points is to be completed by the each local Chapter President or Secretary and are to be made daily by 11:59 PM PST in the [respected daily folder on the Google Drive](#) in addition to email submission to the International CAO.

Submission Steps:

1. Complete [NMWC Point Submission Form](#)
2. Upload NMWC Point Submission Form to [respective day Folder](#)
3. Email confirmation of submission of NMWC Point Submission Form to the secretary@naturopathicstudent.org daily

Rules:

1. **Social Media Points have a daily max of 40 points.** These will be counted using the [designated hashtags](#) as assigned by NMSA International.
2. **Event Points will be counted as daily events.** This means that your team gets points for events daily, but you do not get points for completing the same event multiple times on the same day. For example, if you host a yoga class everyday, you get the 20 points for each day and 100 points by the end of the week. If your chapter were to host five yoga classes on the same day, you would only for 20 points for the day, not 100 points. Similarly, if your chapter was to sell one Therapeutic Order Poster each day of the week, your team would get 50 points by the end of the week, if your team were to sell 5 posters in one day, you would only get 10 points for the day. This is in an effort to make it fair between the larger and smaller schools who have differing ability to sell higher quantities.
3. **There will be no event crossover.** Each event can only count as one event. For example, you cannot host a yoga class and have it also count as your cohort team building event. It will only count as a yoga class (worth 20 points) vs as both a yoga class (worth 20 points) and a cohort team building event (worth 40 points) and would not earn you 60 points for the one event.
